### ***2019 Spring Grants Available for Nonprofits Serving the North Penn Region***

The VNA Foundation of Greater North Penn provides a spring and a fall grant cycle each year to support local nonprofit organizations which strengthen lives along a continuum of need, thus building stronger and healthier communities in this region for generations to come.

Each Spring, the VNA Foundation provides up to \$20,000 to local nonprofit partners serving the North Penn community, in order to support program, operations, or capacity-building projects for **nonprofits serving the North Penn region** of Montgomery County which seek to more effectively and efficiently fulfill their local mission to the community. Applications will be considered only if there is a primary focus on serving the North Penn region (North Penn, Souderton, and Wissahickon School Districts, as well as Worcester Twp), with 60% or more of those served residing in this North Penn region.

Letters of Intent must be submitted online, and will be available to complete online through the foundation's website ([www.npvnafoundation.org](http://www.npvnafoundation.org)), between these dates:

**January 4, 2019 – February 1, 2019**

The LOI will require specific goals to be defined under the grant request and should focus on addressing *positive outcomes projected in serving individuals and families residing within the North Penn region of Montgomery County*. Nonprofit organizations may request general operating support, program support, or capacity-building support, yet the request must connect directly to how this potential grant support would specifically benefit residents of the North Penn region of Montgomery County.

All Letters of Intent (LOI) must be submitted by Close of Business on February 1, 2019 in order to be considered within this grant cycle. Those with a successful LOI will be invited to complete an application and will be notified of this in February. An application and review process will then occur, with grants awarded by June 2019.
